Accreditation Pass



We have recently completed the testing of one of our spreaders in conjunction with Accu-Spread and the Australian Fertiliser Service Association. The day spent at Strathmerton VIC showed that our spreading results fall within the parameters of a five percent variation over 15 metres, which is an excellent result, and extremely beneficial for the likes of those in the dairy industry.

Those at the testing also noted the fact that the integrity of the products being trialed (single super, urea and pasture booster) was not compromised. These results also confirm that our hopper-discharge spout-spinner configuration allow the granulated products to be dispensed in their intended form, and that the product is able to fertilise as designed.
